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




Global growth continues


The acceleration of economic growth makes more necessary to examine its relationship with environmental sustainability

The acceleration in economic growth creates an increasing necessity to consider its links to the environment, as global CO₂ emissions start to rise again.


 % change CO₂ emissions from international shipping

Global New Investment in Renewable Power and Fuels




World employment trends


Global Overview

- These changes brighten the prospects for affordable, sustainable energy & require a reappraisal of approaches to energy security




India takes the lead, as China energy growth slows

Change in world energy demand by fuel




Low-carbon sources & natural gas meet 85% of the increase in global demand

Change in world energy demand by fuel




China's switch to a new economic model & a cleaner energy mix drives global trends

Global average annual net capacity additions by type





 Sources of global electricity demand growth




India adds the equivalent of today's EU to its electricity generation by 2040 while China adds the eq. of today's US

 Global oil demand



Oil and gas production in the United States





Conclusions

- The oil and gas boom in the United States is changing trends, with important implications for markets, trade flows, investment and energy security
- The Chinese energy revolution will boost cost reduction for a wide range of clean energy technologies
- The Sustainable Development Scenario for sustainable energy shows that actions to tackle climate change are compatible with universal access to energy and air quality
- Electrification and digitalization are the future of many parts of the global energy system, creating new opportunities
- Despite the penetration of renewable energies, the demand for oil and gas is expected to be stable in the future




Global Oil & Gas Overview



Distribution of proved reserves: 1996, 2006 and 2016 (Percentage)
















Oil consumption per capita 2016 (Tonnes)




Gas consumption per capita 2016 (Tonnes oil equivalent)









Challenges in organizing women

- Lack of interest to join the union
- Difficulties to change the mind-set
 of male reps
- Difficulties to get the works councils to have women interests in mind
- Difficulties for traditionally male dominated unions to know women's interest
- Time constraints and caring responsibilities
- Fear of job loss (women-head of households)

Specific Organizing strategies:

- Establishing quotas
- Establishing women's structures
- Training (women organisers/leadership training)
- Campaigns to increase women's representation

Challenges faced by women in sectors

- Inequality and discrimination
- Horizontal and vertical segregation
- Lack of maternity protection (working conditions during the pregency, security of job)
- Violence and harassment against women

Including women issues in CBA

- Monitoring of decrease of gender wage gap
- Improving maternity protection
- Language on Childcare and Family rights
- Language on violence and harassment at work
- Leaves for domestic violence

To demand that employers develop policies against all forms of violence and harassment at work, and promote awareness among their employees on the devastating impacts of violence against women and the importance of eradicating it

To demand that employers develop concrete policies and procedures to prevent and combat all forms of violence against women in their premises and supply chains, and establish safe mechanisms for women to turn to if they are assaulted or attacked at work

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To include demands for the eradication of violence and harassment against women in our collective bargaining claims.
