



























EXICO DAYS OF ACTION 18-24 FEBRUARY 2013

This week, the international labour movement is mobilizing in solidarity with the Independent and Democratic Trade Union Movement in Mexico. In México, the employers use "protection contracts" by which they form and finance company unions and, in that way, they deny workers the right to have a real union and a collective agreement that benefits them. When workers try to create their own union they are persecuted, fired and, in many cases, even violently intimidated by goons from the false union.

Tenaris workers in Mexico are subjected to a "protection contract." The workers in that plant are currently fighting to get rid of their fake union and are looking for real leadership. The Tenaris Workers' World Council demands that Tenaris allows their workers to form their own union and to renounce the "protection contract."
